



Microsoft Describes Power Apps as:

A service for building and using custom business apps that connect to your data and work across the web and mobile - without the time and expense of custom software development.






How to get it:

Flow

Microsoft Describes Flow as:

A cloud-based software tool that allows employees to create and automate workflows across multiple applications and services without the need for developer help. Automated workflows are called **flows**.





Flow

Flow has myriad available templates to get you started. Some examples:

- Track expenses
- Receive push notifications
 - Files added to SharePoint
 - Emails received from specific people
- Automatically save email attachments to specific locations
- Get daily news updates from CNN



Stream

Microsoft Describes Stream as:

A single destination for video management, with built-in intelligence, deep integration across Office 365 and the IT management and security capabilities that businesses of all sizes require. It gives individuals a destination to contribute, search and discover all their company videos.



Microsoft Stream

Organizing videos with groups and channels



Stream

- Content can be organized by Group and Channel
- Integrates with
 - Teams
 - SharePoint
 - OneNote
 - Yammer
- You have the ability to add captions and subtitles to your videos
- It will AUTOTRANSCRIBE your video content



Sway

Microsoft Describes Sway as:


An easy-to-use digital storytelling app for creating interactive reports, presentations, personal stories and more. Its built-in design engine helps you create professional designs in minutes.





Sway

 You can find content for your presentation right from within the application via the "Insert" button:



- Images are also searchable so if you need a picture of a dinosaur, the internet is at your fingertips
- Much like PowerPoint, you can set animations and slide transitions



Forms

Microsoft Describes Forms as:

A tool that allows you to create surveys, quizzes, and polls, and easily see results as they come in. When you create a quiz or **form**, you can invite others to respond to it using any web browser, even on mobile devices.
